The successful applicant will receive a one-time cash bursary in the amount of **\$2,500**.

### Eligibility & Selection Criteria

The recipient of the 2020 IBAS Young Community Leader Bursary will:

1. Be a Grade 12 student in Saskatchewan, graduating in the spring of 2020, with an intent to pursue a higher education within the next two years;
2. Demonstrate an exceptional commitment to their community through volunteerism, school involvement, leadership of local initiatives, or other means of engagement;
3. Be a role model in their community; and
4. Demonstrate academic dedication and achievement with a minimum cumulative Grade 11 average of 75%.
